We do a free, after-school tutoring program for at-risk children in the community. In addition, we have an emotional support program to help these children cope with anxiety and despair and improve their feelings of self-worth. We also make available a series of educational programs for children about what faith teaches us about important things like kindness and forgiveness.
